**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northamptonshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 84 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed exceeding 20mph in either direction along those lengths of roads as specified in the Schedule below.

A **COPY** of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the exact lengths of road to which it relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at Oundle Library, Glaphorn Road, Oundle during its normal opening hours or at the offices of the Traffic Orders Section, Riverside House, Bedford Road, Northampton during normal office hours.

**OBJECTIONS** to the proposed Order, stating the grounds on which they are made should be sent in writing to the Traffic Orders Section, Riverside House, Riverside Way, Bedford Road, Northampton NN1 5NX by 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2014.

**SCHEDULE**

1. New Street – between its junction with West Street and a point 205 metres north of that junction.
2. West Street – between its junction with New Street and a point 85 metres west of that junction.
3. Market Place – entire length.
4. Church Street – entire length
5. Jericho – entire length
6. North Street – between its junction with Market Place and a point 55 metres north of that junction.
