## Please look out for advanced warning signs Highway works on Glapthorn Road, Oundle

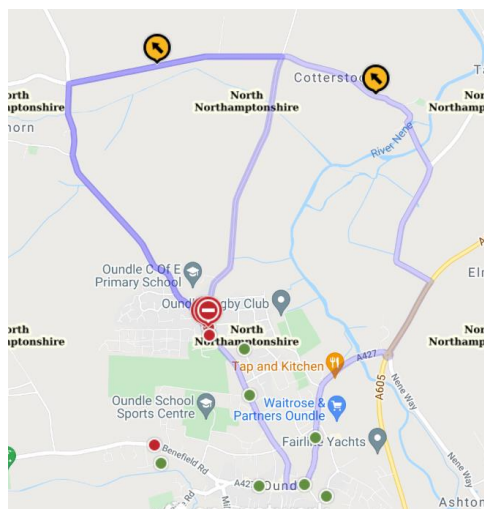
- **Start date:** Monday 23 May
- **Completion:** Tuesday 24 May
- **Scheme type:** Carriageway high-friction surfacing at the crossing point
- **Traffic management:** Full closure and diversion
- **Hours of work:** 09:00– 15:30 Monday and Tuesday



**What we are doing/the benefits** – Northamptonshire Highways are scheduled to carry carriageway resurfacing as part of the crossing upgrade works. This will involve resurfacing the approaches to the crossing point with a high friction surfacing.

### Traffic Management:

To maintain the health and safety of the workforce and the public the works will be carried out under a road closure. This will be in place for the duration of the surfacing works. The plan below shows the extents of the works shown in the **red circle**. The diversion routes are shown in **blue**.



**Access for residents:** will be maintained at all times if safe to do so. However, there will be times where this will not be possible during the resurfacing. Please allow extra time for your journeys and consult with the Site Manager on the contact details below to discuss access arrangements.

**Pedestrians:** Pedestrian routes will be available throughout the works.

**Cyclists:** Please dismount and walk through the pedestrian routes

**Public transport:** during the closure, should your bus route be affected, please contact your bus operator for further information.
