Nov 29th – joined discussion between Clerk with **Maverick** about grant finding for skatepark.

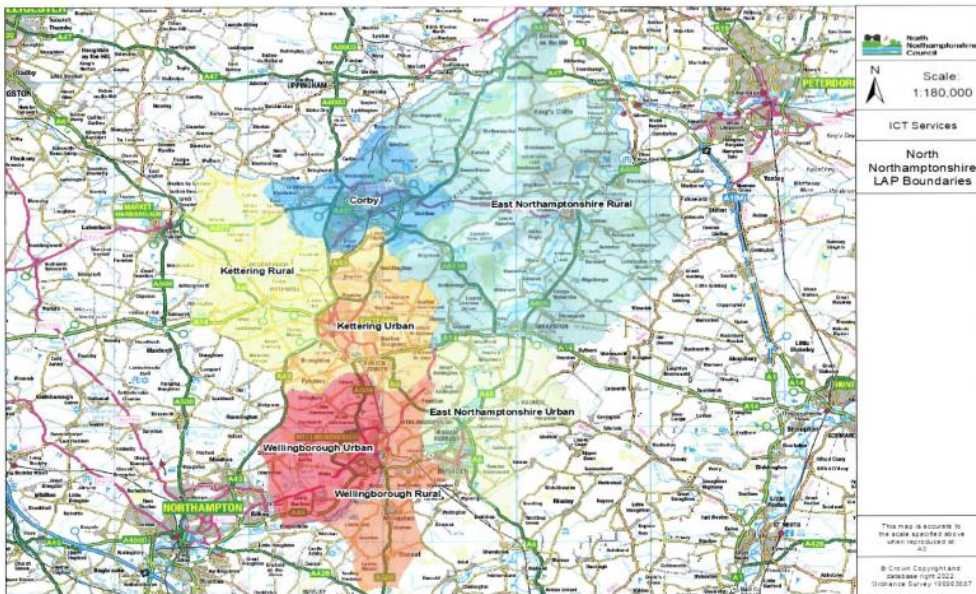
