20.73. Apologies for Absence

20.77. To consider new road scheme in the town to allow people to pass the queues outside the Pharmacy and Post Office.

The temporary works scheme for St Osyth's Lane was approved. It was agreed that the Clerk would ask if the scheme could be modified to include barriers on the other side of the road also to allow pupils from Oundle School to exit the gate on St Osyth's Lane safely.

20.78. To receive an update on the skatepark following the recent ROSPA inspection and to discuss the future of the skatepark.

The update was received. The Clerk informed the meeting that she had been contacted by

a local skatepark company who was keen to assist us with the repairs to the half pipe. It was agreed that it this would be a good idea.

20.79. To consider application for a premises licence for Oundle News, 3 Market Place, Oundle.
Following a discussion it was agreed that the Council would object to the application as there are already a large number of places within the market place where alcohol could be purchased and there was no need for another licensed premise.

20.80. To consider setting up working party to look at the North Northants Unitary Council.
It was agreed that the Clerk send a letter to all the parish councils within the Oundle area to invite them to join the working party. Cllr Chapple agreed to draft the letter and circulate it to the Councillors. It was agreed that Cllrs Peel, Chapple, Humphreys, Clark and Glen would be members of the working party.

20.81. Any Other Relevant Matters for Report Only

Cllr Humphreys asked of the Council was going to respond to the planning white paper consultation. The Clerk informed the meeting that it was going to be on the 15th September meeting. The Mayor asked all councillors to go through the document before the meeting.


The Mayor informed the meeting about the complaint he had received about the Cemetery. The Clerk suggested it go on the September 15th meeting agenda.
