Cllr Hutton gave an update on the progress of the submission. Both Cllr Hutton and Cllr Humphreys have attended two meetings with Oundle Business Association members to discuss the proposal. The proposal is to improve the area around the War Memorial and to

build on the footfall into the town for this we are asking for Bid £400, 000 funding over 4 years which will require match funding.

6.40pm Cllr Baker arrived at the meeting.

It was agreed that even if we do not get through this first stage in the process it has been a worthwhile exercise to form a vision for the town which can be built on.

It was agreed that Cllrs Hutton and Humphreys have authorisation to continue to work on the bid, which they will circulate to all Council members for comment prior to submission on 12th July 2019.

A discussion arose about tidying up the town centre by filling the planters with flowers and asking the business owners in the town to assist with watering.

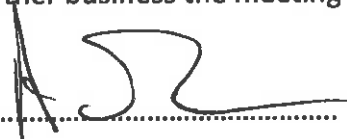
The Clerk will look into planters for the town and costs of hiring for a future Estates Agenda.
