18.184. Neighbourhood Plan

18.184.01. To receive an update from the Neighbourhood Plan Working Party.
Cllr Peel gave an update on the progress since the last NP Council meeting.

All the concerns from ENC will have been addressed before the NP is presented to ENC at the ENC public meeting on 18th February. Cllr Peel informed the meeting that our consultant has said that we do not need to repeat Regulation 14 again. It was agreed that although we do not have to repeat the reg 14 consultation we should consider the comments received during the Regulation 14 consultation in April 2018. Two of the sites in our NP received criticism from residents. It was agreed that we should find out from our consultant whether a decision needs to be made about the contentious sites before we present the draft plan to ENC.

18.184.02. To discuss the ENC Site Assessment work for Oundle and consider if Oundle Town Council should lodge a formal complaint as the information was not available until after OTC responded to the Local Plan consultation.

It was agreed that a complaint should be sent to ENC as the information was not available at the time of the consultation. Had the site assessments been available we would have been able to comment on them. It was resolved that Oundle Town Council raise a formal complaint that the supporting documentation was not made available to the Town Council or the resident of Oundle. The consultation period should be opened again to enable the people of Oundle to comment.

Cllr Peel and Cllr Robinson informed the meeting that the plan for the proposed bus route has been received. The 3 tonne weight restriction will be in place by 4th February along with all the signage.
