19.155. Neighbourhood Plan

19.155.01. To receive an update on Neighbourhood Plan / Local Plan actions since the last meeting.

Cllr Peel informed the meeting that he would be meeting with Tom Pursglove along with the some of the members of the NP working party on 7th February.

The Mayor informed the meeting that at present there are 3 things happening.

The Local Plan still has to go through the examination and it is felt that it could be rejected as it has not gone through the correct lawful processes.

There are 3 contentious planning applications to be considered at ENC in the next couple of months.

1. Development on Fletton field to be considered at the Planning Management Committee meeting on 12th February. ENC recommend it to be refused.

2. Development on land at Cotterstock Road to be considered on 26th February at ENC

3. Development on land off St Christopher's Drive to be considered at on 23rd March site at ENC.

The complaint against ENC is at the next stage in the process.

The Council has received good feedback supporting the Council which is encouraging.

It was agreed that Cllr Hutton go through the plan to extract the items that we would like to be included in the Local Plan.

19.155.02. To finalise the arrangements for the Town Meeting to be held on 13th February at the Queen Victoria Hall, West Street, Oundle at 7.30pm.

The final arrangements for the meeting were agreed. Cllr Clark has a projector he can bring and will see if he can borrow a screen as well.

The Clerk shall ensure that the microphones are working and will check them prior to the meeting.


19.156. Any Other Relevant Matters for Report
