At the town meeting in November the residents voted against the Local Plan. However, they have also not received any response to the comments they made on the Oundle Neighbourhood Plan during the Regulation 14.

The residents, who spoke on behalf of the residents of St Christopher's Drive listed their objections to the proposed developments at St Christopher's Drive. They suggested that the site is not developed for housing but is kept as a piece of land for future use for Prince William School.

Cllr Stearn suggested that the residents should voice their objections at the ENC public meeting on 18th February.

The Mayor informed the meeting that the points will be addressed at a later day as there was not enough time to go through them during this meeting.

18.203.03. To consider the draft Sustainability Appraisal (SA) information from the Neighbourhood Plan consultant.

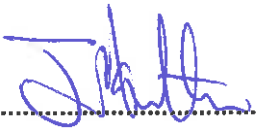
Both Appendices drafted by the consultant were discussed which covered the preferred options from the Sustainability report for the sites selected in the NP.

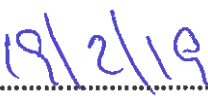
A meeting will be arranged with the Consultant to go through the documents.
