Cllr Chapple expressed his concerns about the Stoke Doyle Road/Cemetery site.

Cllr Sparkes again expressed his concerns regarding the removal of the Cotterstock Road and Ashton Road sites from the Neighbourhood Plan and reiterated his concerns that these sites could end up being developed with more than 500 houses.
