**SECTION 15(3) OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006**


**IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE  
REGISTRATION OF LAND KNOWN AS 'FLETTON FIELD', OFF  
FLETTON WAY, GLAPTHORN ROAD, OUNDLE**

Notice is hereby given that the Commons Registration Authority, on 24 July 2017, considered the application submitted by Oundle Town Council to register in the Register of Town and Village Greens the land described in the application as land known as 'Fletton Field', off Fletton Way, Glapthorn Road, Oundle Northamptonshire.

Northamptonshire County Council as the Commons Registration Authority has decided to **reject** the application and make no changes to the Register of Town and Village Greens. On the basis of all the evidence submitted, and having regard to the submissions received and the recommendation in the report of the Independent Inspector, it was considered that the applicant failed to prove that a significant number of inhabitants of Oundle Town indulged in Lawful Sports and Pastimes on 'Fletton Field' for a period of at least 20 years before qualifying use ended on 9 December 2015 and that use has not been "as of right" but instead was by right", for the reasons:-

- As set out in the Inspectors report dated 15 May 2017.
