

## **Continued issues with New Road and Anglia Water**

OTC recently contacted Anglia Water about recurring issues on New Road. They replied that vibrations from heavy traffic (rerouted X4, construction traffic for the Sports Centre and the work to re-surface the road) likely caused collars on pipes to leak, and are confident that as the road now has a chance to settle, there shouldn't be any further problems. We'll keep a watching brief!

## **A message from Northants Police about speeding**

"The Police were recently notified of the results of the Speed indicator device installed by Oundle Town Council on WEST STREET. Whilst the vast majority of speeds were at or below 28 mph, we were dismayed that over the month, the speed limit was broken over 2000 times, with a few offenders over 70mph.

The message from us is clear - driving licences are a privilege, not a right. Magistrates will consider fines and points to those who appear before them. Insurance increases and points remain on a licence for at least 3yrs. The same applies to parking on double yellow lines in the town – on top of fines,

vehicles can be removed for obstruction.”
