Did you know?

As you cross the bridge toward the old railway station and the A605 roundabout, you enter Ashton parish. This charming village near Oundle boasts a rich history, with its manor recorded in the 1086 Domesday Book and an infamous unsolved double murder from 1952. Rebuilt in 1900 by the Rothschild family, Ashton is renowned for its distinctive character, free-roaming peacocks, and the Chequered Skipper pub. One of Ashton’s most notable figures is **Miriam Rothschild (tinyurl.com/MiriamRFT)**, a distinguished natural scientist and author born in 1908. Ashton is also the birthplace of the **World Conker Championship (tinyurl.com/Worldconker)** held annually in Southwick—a fun-filled event for the whole family.
