C H A R I T Y   C O M M I S S I O N .

In the Matter of the Charity known as QUEEN VICTORIA HALL, at OUNDLE, in the County of NORTHAMPTON, comprised in a Declaration of Trust dated the 12th March 1904; and In the Matter of the Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1939.

THE BOARD OF CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES, upon an application made to them on the 31st May 1945, in writing, signed by

HERBERT HUNT MARKHAM, of 1 East Road, Retired Stationer,  
BASIL GUY LUDLOW, of 51 North Street, Brewer,  
PERCIVAL KNIGHT, of 2 New Street, Bank Manager, and  
PERCIVAL JOHN NORTH, of 38 Glapthorne Road, Butcher,  
all in Oundle, and

HARRY TANY, of National Fire Service Headquarters, Midland Road, Thrapston, in the County of Northampton, Company Officer, National Fire Service;  
the Trustees of the above-mentioned Charity:

AND after due notice of the intention to make this Order published according to the direction of the Board by being affixed to or near a principal outer door of the Parish Church of Oundle and of the Hall of the Charity on the 14th November 1945 (being more than one calendar month before the date hereof):

AND having received no notice of any objection to the proposed Order or suggestion for the variation thereof:

DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:-

The subjoined Scheme is approved and established as the Scheme for the regulation of the Charity.

S C H E M E

1. The above-mentioned Charity and the endowments thereof specified in the schedule hereto shall be administered and managed by the Urban District Council of Oundle, as the Trustees of the Charity, in accordance with the provisions of the said Declaration of Trust, save that clauses 18, 20, 21, 22, 25 and 26 thereof shall cease to have effect.

2. The land described in the said schedule is hereby vested in the said Council for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.
